Character

Disguised as a nondescript ridge, initially you believe it's a footpath, but at the latest on the slightly overhanging final-wall you notice that you are climbing in one of the most difficult climbing route in the Gastein Valley. The highlight is hanging in the wall in the second D Passage - an old I-liftchair as a photo point.

Equipment for via ferratas

Climbing harness, via ferrata protection and helmet are absolutely necessary! For beginners we recommend the attendance of a mountain guide!

Scale of difficulty

A: easy | B: moderately difficult | C: difficult | D: very difficult | E: extremely difficult

There is danger to life in via ferratas during thunderstorms! Be aware of rockfall due to antedates!
