The wide pistes and slopes provide the ultimate joy of skiing and are speedily accessible via the Schlossalmbahn: 'non-stop to the top'. Freeriders also get their money's worth on the Schlossalm, numerous variants and a ski route guarantee pure "off-piste" fun.

Ski Center Angertal
Your first steps on snow

First attempts on skis and snowboards - especially for children and ski beginners is the Ski Center Angertal with the large exercise area, the easy slopes and the child-friendly lifts exactly the right thing. The Ski Center Angertal is the hub between the Schlossalm and the Stubnerkogel.

The Stubnerkogel in Bad Gastein not only promises breathtaking 360° panoramic views of the surrounding mountain landscape, it also has the right offer for each and every skier. That said, the legendary 140 m long suspension bridge and scenic lookout points such as the Glocknerblick, the Talblick and the Felsenweg also guarantee non-skiers "mountains full of beautiful moments".

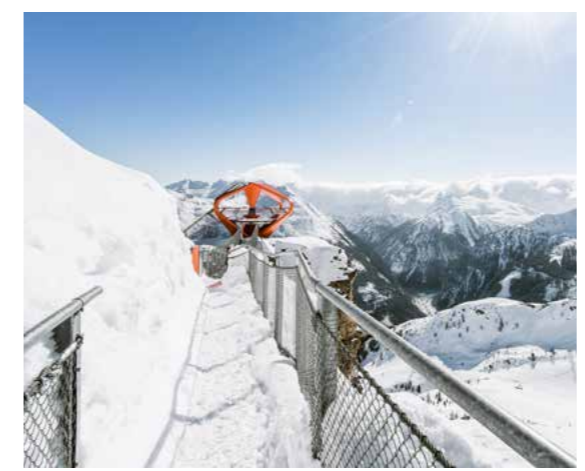
Winter operations 2023/24

The opening of the ski areas depends on the snow conditions. During season periods Ski amadé Start and Final skiing may be limited to certain areas and/or to weekend operation (e.g. Stubnerkogel, Angertal or Sportgastein only). The prices (from 2 days) as well as the seasonal terms can be found on the website. When seasons overlap a mixed price will be charged. The General Terms and Conditions apply (see the notice board at the cash desk and/or at the lifts).



Weekly program

Ski Safari - every Monday:

Summit Breakfast - every Wednesday from 27.12.2023 to 10.04.2024:
Summit conquest and breakfast in high-altitude Sportgastein at 2.650 meters. Meeting at 8.45 a.m. at the valley station Goldbergbahn. Registration until Tuesday 3 p.m. at the tourist office Bad Gastein (+43 6432 3393 560, badgastein@gastein.com)
