Enjoy an extraordinary sunset experience with live music, the sounds of alpine horns, flickering torches and warming fires.

At the Stubner Summit Restaurant, you can indulge in culinary delights well into the night. At the Hirsch & Maus mountain restaurant, enjoy hearty regional specialties, live music and stunning views from the terrace.

A VALLEY LEARNS TO RESCUE

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With the campaign “A Valley Learns to Rescue”, first aid in the mountains becomes an exciting hands-on experience! On two dates this summer, the Gastein Red Cross will demonstrate on Schlossalm how to perform CPR, handle medical emergencies and treat injuries in a practical way.

The three stations near the Schlossalmbahn mountain station are free of charge, hands-on and set up in a realistic alpine environment. Anyone who completes all stations will receive a certificate and a small gift.

TIP

On these dates, you can reach Schlossalm from Stubnerkogel via the hiking circuit (Senderbahn and Kaserebenbahn) through Angertal.

NASSFELDER ALMFEST

August

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Discover the Hohe Tauern National Park in Sportgastein with live music and culinary delights such as traditional Brettljause platters and locally produced cheese at the mountain huts in Nassfeld. Ride the Goldbergbahn cable car up the mountain and enjoy a spectacular high-alpine panorama of the surrounding 3,000-metre peaks. With just a 5-minute walk, you can reach the summit cross at Kreuzkogel (2,650 m) and take in breathtaking views of the alpine landscape.
