

06 Guided pine-path hike on Graukogel

09.07.2025 - 01.10.2025

Every Wednesday, enjoy a leisurely hike guided by Hans Naglmayr through the impressive stone pine forest on the Graukogel. It is known for its stone pine trees, which are up to 300 years old. The trail starts directly at the mountain station of the Graukogel cable car and leads past lovingly designed rest areas, stone pine loungers and even a large outdoor stone pine bed. The stone pine has a calming effect on body and mind. An approx. 4-hour experience for all the senses!

Stone pine trees as far as the eye can see. The extensive and almost 300-year-old stand of fragrant trees is the flagship of the Graukogel in Bad Gastein and a popular destination for those seeking peace and quiet. This special feature is celebrated at the Swiss stone pine festival on the Graukogel with a children's programme, music, wood carving and a guided hike along the Swiss stone pine trail.

From 12.30 p.m. there will be musical entertainment with the Schachen Buam at the Graukogelhütte. Bricolage MMitterhofer offers a creative programme for children, while Sauschneid Sepp delights with his impressive woodworking skills. A varied afternoon for the whole family!

Alpine festival in Nassfeld

09.08.2025-10.08.2025

Experience the Hohe Tauern National Park in Sportgastein with musical sounds and culinary delicacies such as snacks and home-made cheese on the alpine pastures in Nassfeld. Take the Goldbergbahn cable car up the mountain for a spectacular and high alpine mountain panorama over the surrounding three thousand metre peaks with only a 5 minute walk to the Kreuzkogel summit cross at 2,650 metres.

What awaits you:
Guided mineral hike. The mountain huts in Sportgastein and the Weitblick restaurant at the middle station are open and spoil their guests with delicacies and a high alpine panorama on the sunny terrace.

10 A valley lerarns to rescue

29.06.2025
& 15.08.2025

With the event 'A valley learns to save', first aid on the mountain becomes an exciting experience! On two dates in summer, the Gastein Red Cross will be demonstrating on the Stubnerkogel how resuscitation, dealing with illnesses and treating injuries work in practice.

The three stations near the mountain station of the Stubnerkogel cable car are free of charge, practical and set up in a realistic environment. Those who complete all the stations receive a certificate and a small gift.

Tip:

On these dates you can reach the Schlossalm from the Stubnerkogel with the hiking swing (Senderbahn and Kaserebenbahn) via the Angertal. A great summit experience!

Programme:

The Red Cross offers 35 minutes of practical instruction at three stations throughout the day on the topic of first aid in the mountains:

- Resuscitation
- Acute emergencies (heart attack, allergic reaction, diabetes)
- Fall and joint injuries

The Stubnerkogel lift in Bad Gastein operates continuously from 8.30 a.m. to 4 p.m.
In bad weather only every hour on the hour.
